to work on counting and recognizing our shapes and letters through the various activities we set out each day.

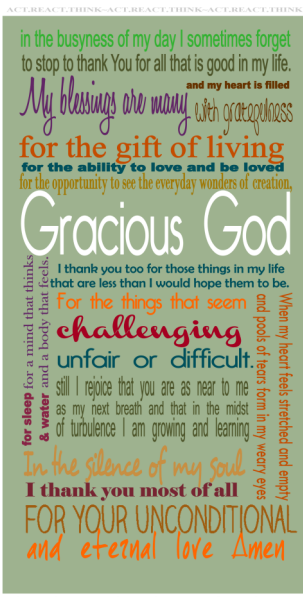
